



Clean Energy Signs LNG Fueling Contract for City of Fresno Municipal Refuse Fleet

-- Agreement Will Supply California's 6th Largest City's Operations --

SEAL BEACH, Calif., May 06, 2008 (BUSINESS WIRE) -- Clean Energy Fuels Corp. (Nasdaq:CLNE) has been awarded a contract to supply liquefied natural gas (LNG) for the City of Fresno, California municipal refuse fleet for up to five years, expanding a fueling relationship begun in 2004.

The Fresno municipal refuse fleet now comprises 80 natural gas trucks and the city has ordered 22 additional natural gas trucks, making it the largest municipal liquefied natural gas refuse fleet in California's Central valley and second largest in California. Fresno is the 6th largest city in California.

"The refuse industry throughout California has been an early adopter of advanced natural gas truck technology and fuel, providing cleaner, cheaper and quieter service," said Andrew J. Littlefair, Clean Energy President and Chief Executive Officer. "We are pleased to assist Fresno in expanding its operations and increasing its cost-savings and clean air contributions to the Fresno community."
